The City will be providing 96-gallon recycling containers in June 2015 to residents that currently have their garbage and recycling picked up by the City.

There are a limited number of 64-gallon recycling containers available on a case-by-case basis for residents that have space constraints or other issues that make a 96-gallon recycling container burdensome. If you would like a 64-gallon container instead of the 96 gallon container, please contact (585) 396-5060 or recycling@canandaiguanewyork.gov. You will need to provide your name, address and reason for requesting the smaller container.

Goals of the Program

- Increase the volume of recycling.** The City conducted a four month pilot program and found that **recycling increased by 128%**. Residents that took part of the program applauded the larger containers and ease of use.
- Realize savings from reduced tipping fees.** An increase in recycling is not only beneficial to our environment, but will save taxpayer dollars with reduced tipping fees at the landfill.
- Reduce worker strain and potential injury.** Currently, City employees are bending over and picking up recycling boxes and extra bags over 1,000 times per day. With the new recycling containers, employees will simply roll the container to the collection vehicle and affix it to the tipper that will pick up the container and dump the material.
- Save from changed collection schedule.** The collection schedule will change from every week to every other week and result in reducing work-hours, fuel consumption and wear and tear on the fleet.

New Recycling Collection Schedule – EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1ST

Garbage will continue to be collected weekly. The new 96-gallon containers will be distributed in June to each household. You should start using the new container when you receive it. The Recycling schedule will not change to every other week until August 1st. Recycling will be collected every other week on your normal collection day as follows:
