#### Leaf & Brush Collection Program '25-'26

City crews will begin collecting loose leaves, city wide on Monday, November 3, 2025 (weather permitting) and will continue through the month of November. In a typical year we complete two full cycles through the city.

Loose leaves must be placed on the grassy area between the sidewalk and curb/pavement edge only. DO NOT rake leaves into the street. Loose leaves in the right-of-way after the month of November will constitute a violation of the Solid Waste Ordinance. City code also requires that private landscaping be maintained so the full width of sidewalk is passable.

#### Sidewalk Snow & Ice Removal Policy

To preserve public safety, in 2004 the City Council adopted a sidewalk snow and ice removal ordinance that requires the removal of snow and ice from the municipal sidewalk by the adjoining property owner and occupant, jointly. The information provided herein advises and gives notice to all property owners and occupants of the properties adjoining municipal sidewalks that per Ordinance 600-12 of the Municipal Code, snow and ice shall be removed from the municipal sidewalk fronting such property within 24 hours of the end of a snow fall.

You are hereby notified that this notice will be the only correspondence you will receive for the upcoming '25-'26 winter season. Sidewalks covered with snow and/or ice after a 24 hr period from the end of a snowfall event, will be cleared of such snow/ice by the Department of Publics Works. The expense associated with such effort will be assessed against the property owner for each occasion requiring such services, as allowed by City Code.
