



City of Canandaigua Sidewalk Snow and Ice Removal Policy 2022- 2023 WINTER SEASON

To preserve public safety, in 2004 the City Council adopted a sidewalk snow and ice removal ordinance that requires the removal of snow and ice from the municipal sidewalk by the adjoining property owner and occupant, jointly.

The information provided herein advises and gives notice to all property owners and occupants of the properties adjoining municipal sidewalks that per Ordinance 600-12 of the Municipal Code, snow and ice shall be removed from the municipal sidewalk fronting such property within 24 hours of the end of a snow fall.

You are hereby notified that this notice will be the only correspondence you will receive for the upcoming 2022- 2023 winter season. Sidewalks covered with snow and/or ice after a 24 hour period from the end of the snowfall event, will be cleared of such snow and ice by the Department of Public Works. The expense associated with such effort will be assessed against the property owner for each occasion requiring such services, as allowed by City Code. Minimum labor and equipment charges are specified in the Sidewalk Snow and Ice Removal Ordinance.

It is important to note that NO FURTHER NOTICES will be provided to the property owner or occupant during the upcoming winter season prior to the City taking action on a dangerous sidewalk condition due to snow and ice accumulation.

If you routinely clear the sidewalk adjacent to your property, thank you for caring for the well-being of those who use the sidewalk.
