- 🐾 OWNERS ARE LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS' ACTIONS AND USE THE PARK AT THEIR OWN RISK.**
- 🐾 This is a membership park, dogs must be registered and wear collar tags. Key cards are non-transferable. Do not allow entry of unregistered users.**
- 🐾 Dogs must remain leashed unless in designated off-leash areas. No extension leashes, pronged, spiked or choke collars are permitted.**
- 🐾 Enter transitional space to play yards one at a time to leash/unleash your dogs.**
- 🐾 Always supervise your dog. Remain in the appropriate play yard with your dogs in view and under voice control at all times. Limit cell phone use.**
- 🐾 No excessively rough play tolerated. Dogs showing signs of aggressive behavior must be leashed and removed from the premises.**
- 🐾 Dogs that are ill, recovering from injury/illness or “in heat” are not permitted.**
- 🐾 No food, treats, alcohol, glass bottles, weapons, wheeled vehicles, brushing/grooming of dogs, personal toys (except balls), or smoking/vaping.**
- 🐾 Dog waste must be bagged and disposed of immediately.**
- 🐾 Owners must discourage digging and refill any holes created by their dogs.**
- 🐾 Children 10+ may enter the park with an adult (18 +) but must be closely supervised.**
- 🐾 Canine caregivers may not bring unregistered dogs into the park. Trainers may not conduct dog training here without City’s permission.**
- 🐾 Call 911 to report a serious, unsafe or unfolding incident. Dog bites can be reported to the Ontario County Humane Society at 585-396-4590 during business hours.**
- 🐾 Call the City Recreation Office at 585-396-5080 to report repairs or park rule violations. Visit canandaiguanewyork.gov or call for more information on membership details.**
